Victoria Faulkner Women's Centre - Housing Program	Between January 2016-March 2016, 34 women accessed. Majority were referred by YWTHS. Most reported having been victims of violence.
Victoria Faulkner Women's Centre - Safe Place Program	Between April 2015-June 2015, saw link between violence against women and experience of precarious housing. Referrals made for a quarter of clients to agencies that support victims.
Salvation Army	Women disclose violence to staff, but the Salvation Army doesn't track it. Some women access due to lack of safety in their homes.
